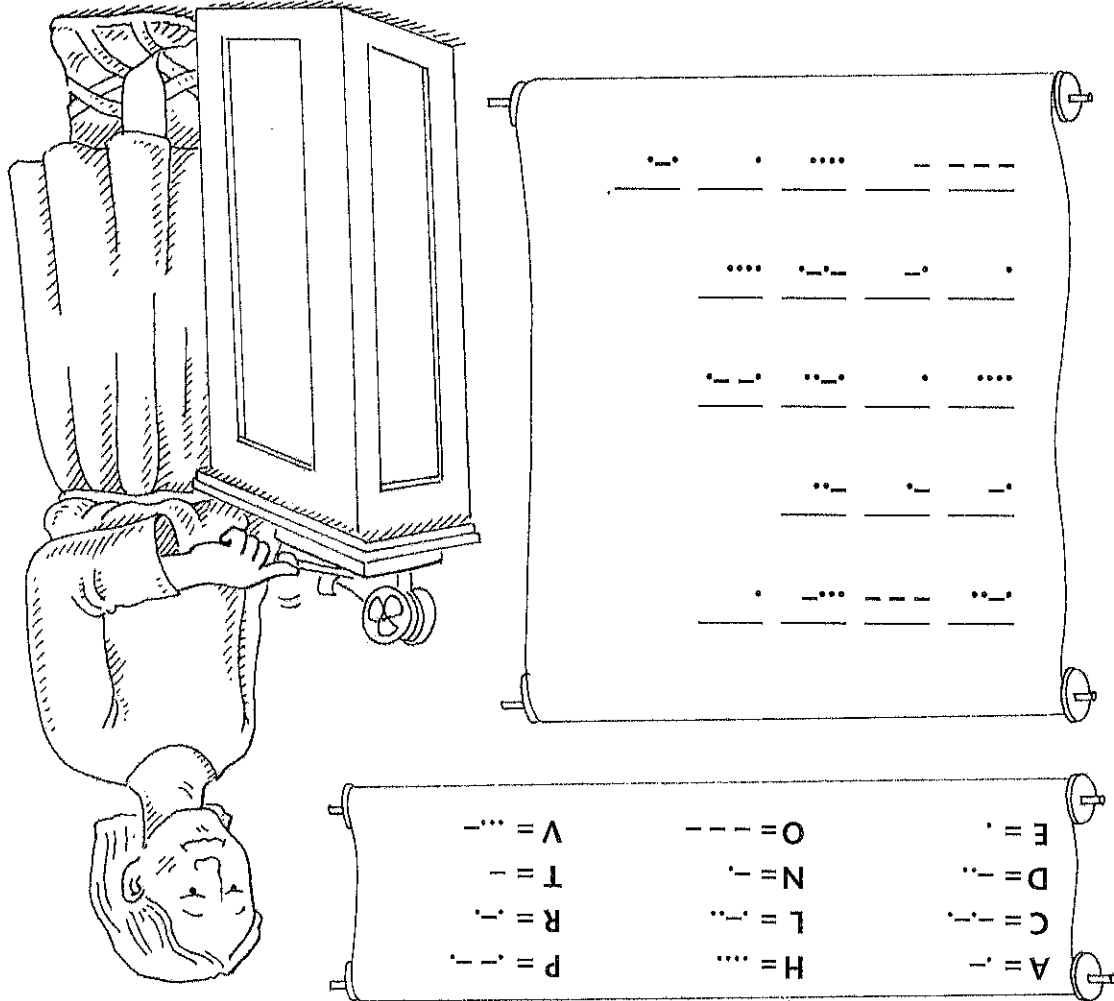

E = .	O = - - -	V = ...-



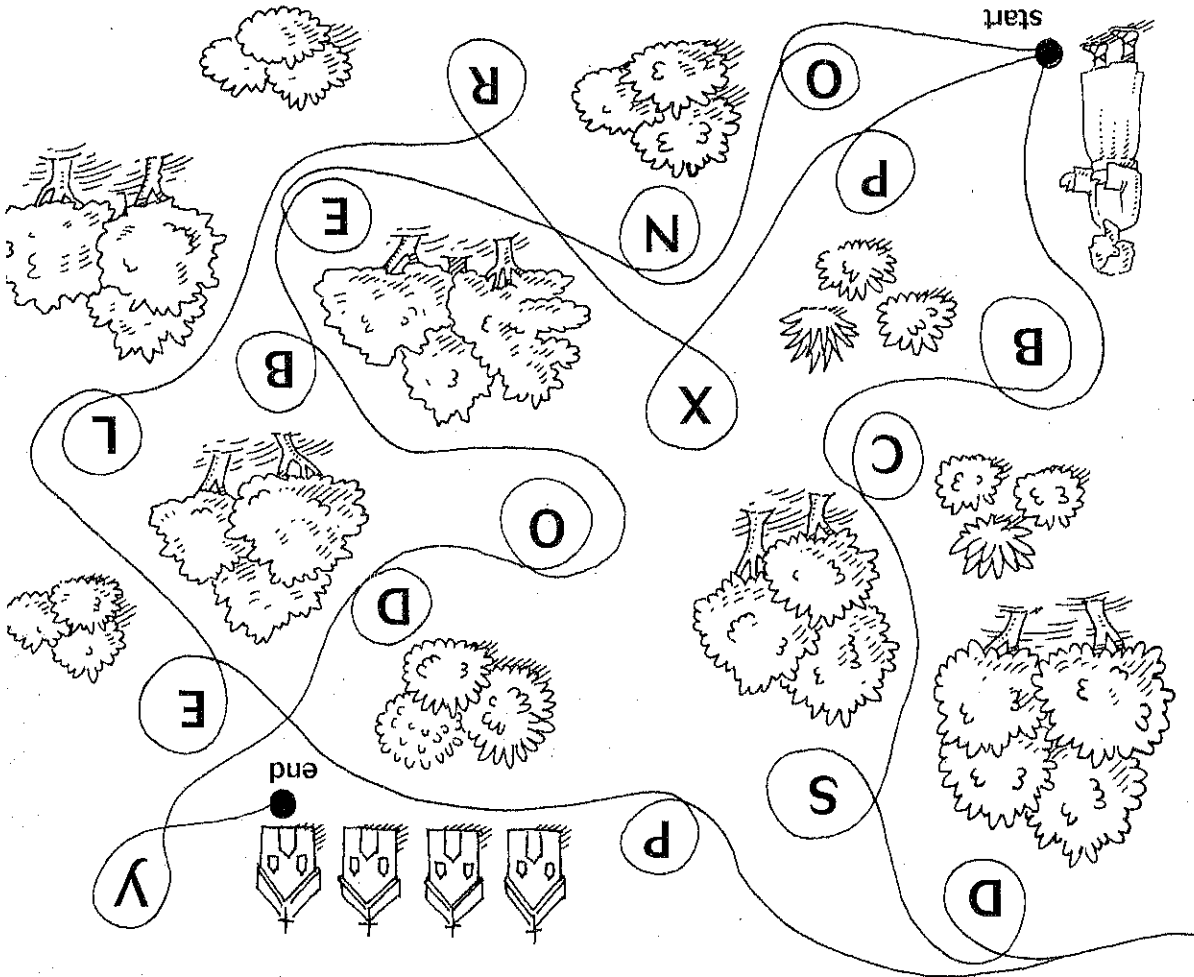
To the Teacher: This activity reinforces the Share activity in Chapter 1.
