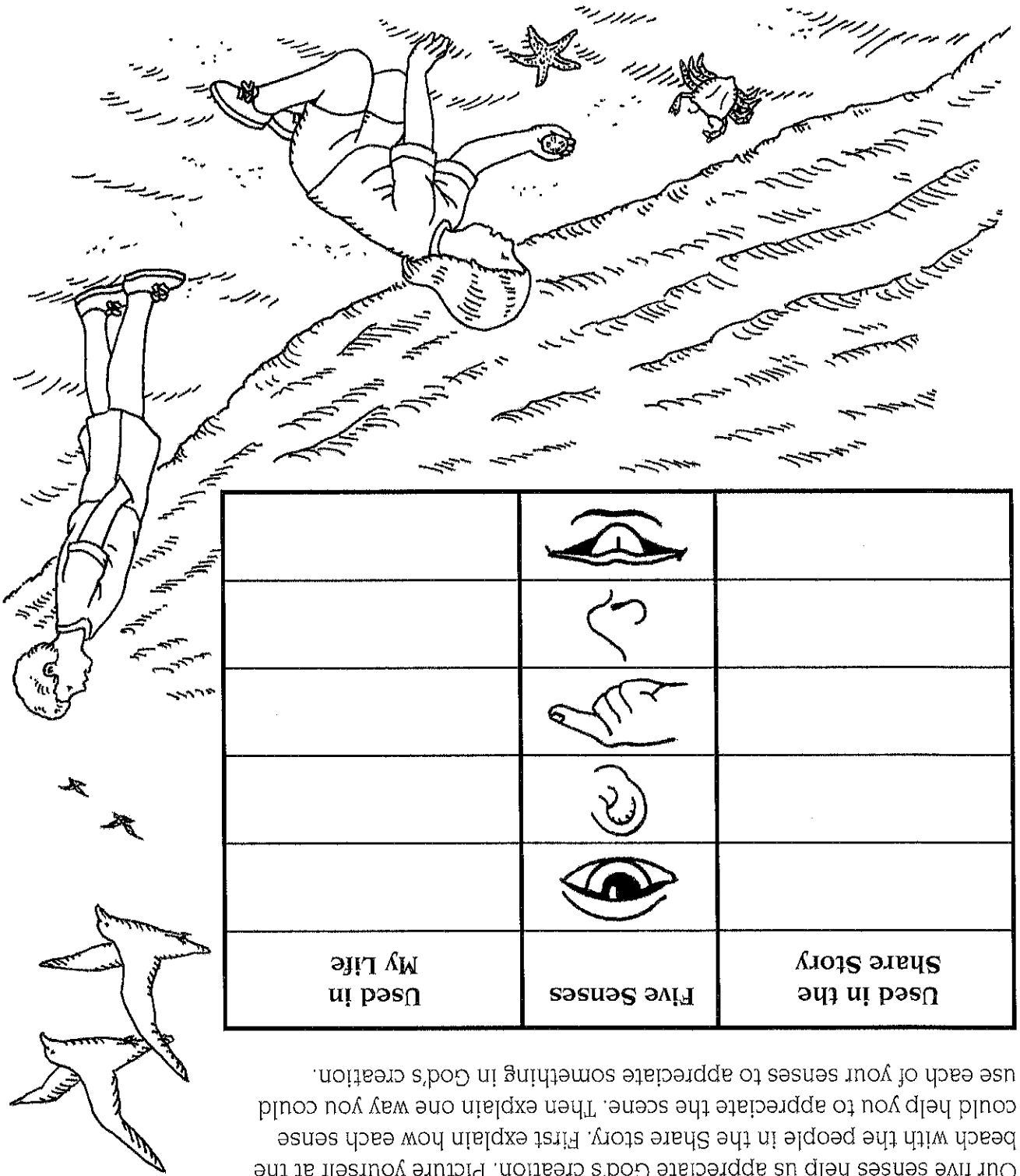

THE THREE R'S

RECYCLE
