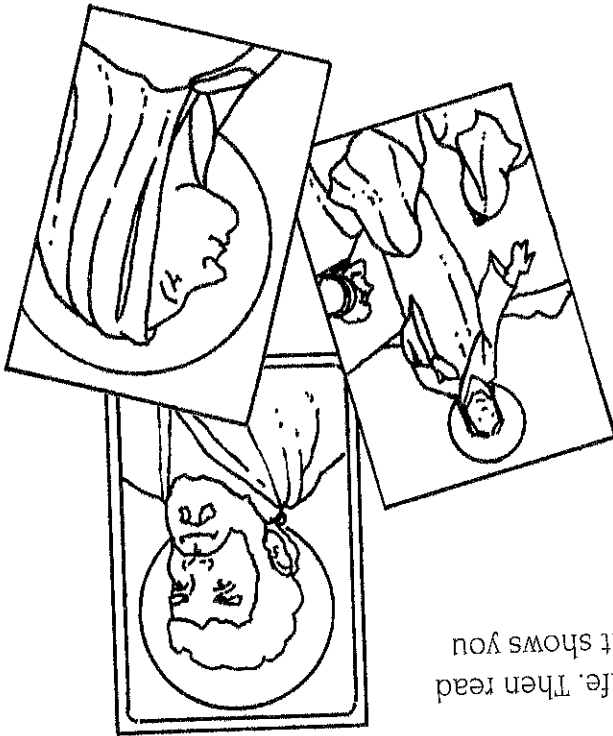


To the Teacher: Use this activity to help children reflect on how they make choices. Invite them to work in small groups to share their cartoons.

Think about the Word of God guiding you through life. Then read the Scripture verses below. Draw a cartoon strip that shows you making a choice based on one of the verses.

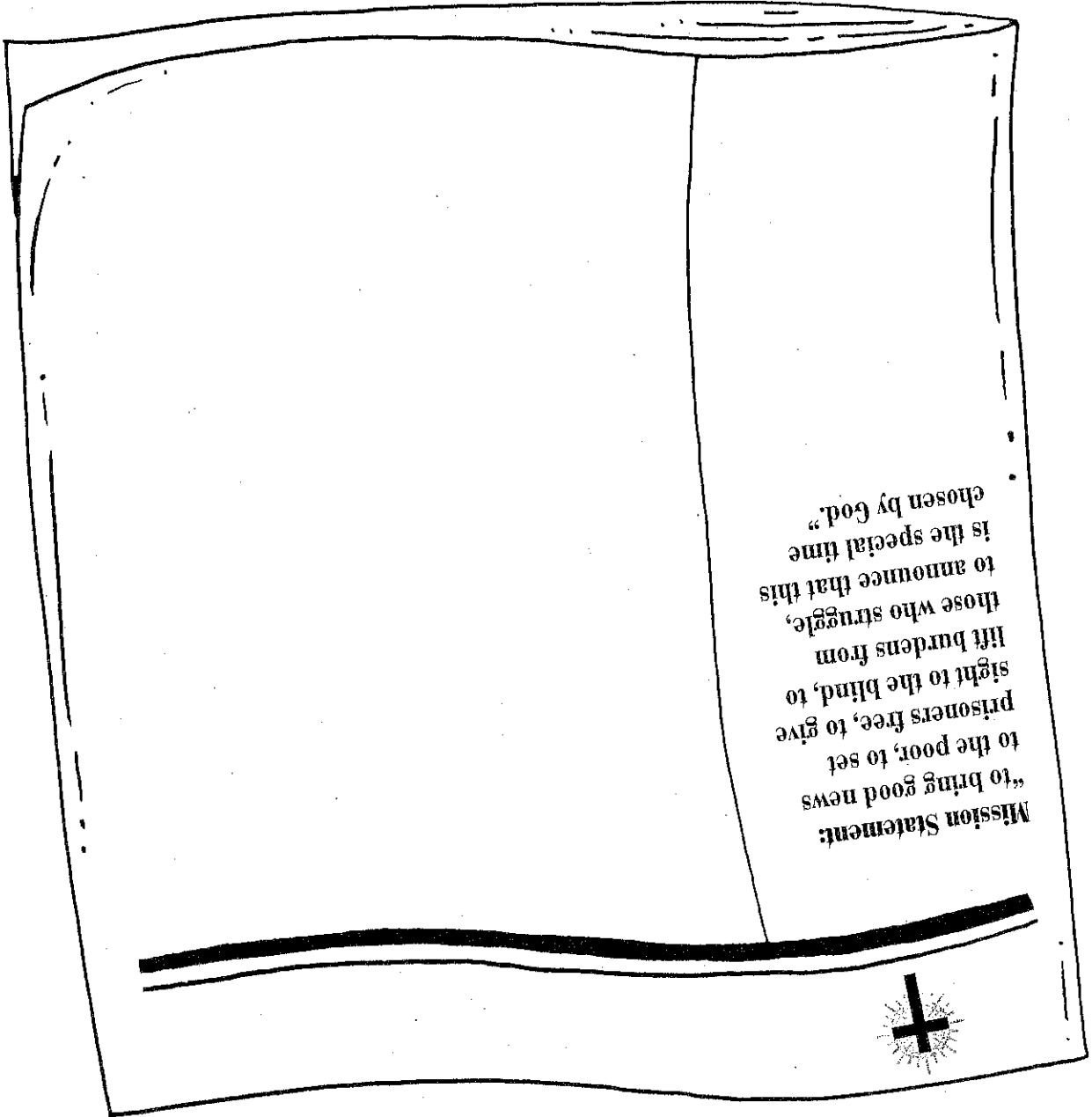
